The Objective (“The Why”): Student Academic Achievement and Social Integration: Students feeling connected to our school is critical for student success. Restorative Justice Programs create healthy, supportive environments that help young people grow and make positive changes in their lives. The goals involve supporting all students socially and emotionally, and generating a 100% graduation and college and career ready rate!

Mission: To Fund a Diversity and Restorative Justice Coordinator.

The Need: Diversity and Restorative Justice give students, teachers and families strategies to address behavior problems and build community in our classrooms and on the entire campus. Riverview is committed to embracing the changing needs of our students. Riverview intends to bring its pockets of excellence to scale and ensure that every child has the opportunity to receive an outstanding education.

Responsibilities of Diversity and Restorative Justice Coordinator:

- Assist with student’s academic progress
- Assist with student’s attendance
- Build a culture leading to reduced student discipline issues on campus
- Work with Drop-Out Prevention Coordinator, Social Workers, and part-time truancy office to support entire Riverview School Community
- “Embrace our differences” and build on the strength of the diversity at Riverview
- Use Restorative Practices to address student conflict and decrease student incidents of behavior
- Lead Restorative Circles as necessary
- Be a community liaison with families in the community
- Design, build and lead leadership opportunities for students
- Provide professional learning experiences for faculty, staff and parents
